Participants are responsible for their own travel arrangements, and for covering approximately \$400 USD in additional meals and incidentals. Each accepted applicant is responsible for seeking their own funding from government, employers, sponsors, or other funding institutions to cover the course fees, visa, all travel expenses, and incidentals.
