- When complete, please email the application along with a resume/CV and two signed letters of recommendation to beahrself@berkeley.edu by January 27th, 2020 at the latest in order for you to qualify for scholarship.
- Please note that the application review will take a few weeks, as we review each application very carefully, so please be patient with the application processing period.
- For international applicants, please note that the actual Visa application times may be much longer than reflected on the U.S. Department of State website, and as such we strongly encourage all international applicants to start the Visa process as early as 6 months in advance.

DEADLINES

- We strongly encourage participants to submit their applications by the first or second review deadlines, as we cannot guarantee that there will be any remaining funds for those who apply after December 27, 2019.
- The 2020 Beahrs ELP application has **three** scholarship review periods:
 - o The deadline for the first round of scholarship review is **November 27, 2019**.
 - o The deadline for the second round of scholarship review is **December 27, 2019**.
 - o The deadline for the final round of scholarship review is **January 27, 2020**.
- Materials submitted after January 27, 2020 will be reviewed but will **NOT** be considered for scholarship.
